- Authors are allowed to submit & present up to 3 abstracts (including short lecture & poster) with one registration.
- For the abstracts that you will submit, please follow the instructions of [Planta Medica](#). The accepted abstracts will be published in a Planta Medica Special Conference Issue devoted to the 71st International Congress and Annual Meeting of the Society for Medicinal Plant and Natural Product Research (you will need to provide your consent on that at the on-line submission platform).
- Your abstract should be no longer than 250 words.
- Abstract body should contain background, aim(s), results, conclusion & conflicts of interest (no headings).
- Only one figure or table is allowed (regarding quality, refer to Planta Medica instructions).
- Figure or table together with its legend (e.g., Figure 1. GC-MS chromatograph of A.t. extract) should be formatted as a single image file (.jpeg or .png). The figure legend should appear under the figure, while the table legend before the table.
- At the end of the main body of the abstract you need to declare if you have any conflicts of interest.
